

NOTICE OF SURVEY FOR HEALTH SERVICES ACCREDITATION

- The National Commission on Correctional Health Care (NCCHC) is a private, not-for-profit organization that has developed national standards for providing health services in correctional facilities. The NCCHC grants accreditation to facilities that comply with its published standards.

- Monroe County Detention Center has voluntarily requested that the National Commission on Correctional Health Care conduct an on-site survey to verify the facility's compliance with the 2014 NCCHC *Standards for Health Services in Jails*.
